



ONE DAY IN SAINT TROPEZ





By car:

HOW TO GO

From the campsite, take the direction of *Les Issambres*, through *Roquebrune sur*Argens and the *Col du Bougnon*, then, driving along the sea, follow Sainte Maxime and Saint

Tropez (or Ramatuelle for beaches).

Once you arrived in Saint Tropez, park right away at *Parking du Port*. Around 3€/hour.

By boat:

Park your car at the carpark of the port in Sainte Maxime or Les Issambres : around 0.60€/15min Take Les Bateaux Verts from:

- <u>Sainte Maxime</u>: 15 minutes journey, every 15-20 minutes, price 14.10€*/adult and 7.80€*/child from 4 to 11 years old (round trip ticket).
- o Returns until 11.20PM until the 3rd of July, and from 30th of August until the 3rd of october;
- o Round trips 24/7 from the 4th of July until the 29th of August.
- <u>Les Issambres</u>: 25 min journey, every hours, price 15€*/adulte and 8.50€*/child (round trip)
- o Every 30 min from the 18th of July until the 25th of August;
- o Returns until 7PM from 6th of June until the 3rd of July and from the 26th of August until the 28th of September;
- o Returns until 11.30PM from the 4th of July until the 25th of August.
- Dogs are allowed, on a leash, for free on boats.

Mask mandatory.

WHAT TO SEE / TO DO



- · Citadel: protected monument with a panoramic view on the bay.
- · Annonciade museum: former Paul Signac's studio and famous international collections.
- *Place des Lices :* french balls courts or market square on Tuesday and Saturday.
- The port: yachts, sailing ships and famous bars.
- · Narrow streets and ready-to-wear fashion luury shops.
- Chanel and Dior houses.
- The old Gendarmerie: famous place of a movie, now the Gendarmerie and Cinema museum (4€/adult, 2€/ 12-18 years, free -12 years old).
- Also, around twenty vineyards in the surroundings like *Château Minuty* or *Domaine de la Tourraque*.
- The famous *Pampelonne beach* where you can meet celebrities!

Market on Tuesdays and Saturdays.

Enjoy an ice cream at Barbarac on the port of Saint Tropez, you'll love it!

Stop at the bakery *La Tarte Tropézienne* in Sainte Maxime to buy the famous cake (created by A. Micka, symbol of pleasure, holidays and sun).

Good to know: if you also want to go in Ramatuelle, it's better to take your car. There is only one road to go in Saint Tropez so it is very crowdy in summer, that's why we advise you to leave in the early morning (9am max) and come back not too late.

But, shuttle boat are available and can be more convenient.
